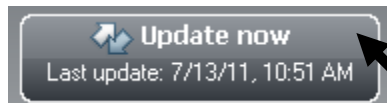


USING AVG ANTIVIRUS

WHY: To protect your computer and data from damage, and to prevent your computer from passing on infections to other machines without your knowledge.

WHEN: This can vary depending on the amount of work you do with your computer. A good rule of thumb is to run AVG Antivirus on a weekly basis. *Sometimes AVG is pre-configured to run a daily scan, usually early in the morning.*

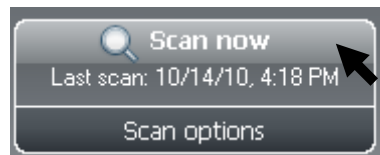
1. Navigate to the AVG 2011 program folder. Click **Start, All Programs, AVG 2011**.
2. Launch the **AVG User Interface**. 
3. Update AVG by clicking the **Update Now** button on the left. AVG will automatically start looking for updates. If there are updates, AVG will automatically download and install them. It may prompt you to confirm; if so, please confirm. If no updates are available AVG will notify you.



4. When complete, click the **Overview** button on the left.



5. To start the scan, click the **Scan now** button on the left.



6. The antivirus scan will begin immediately. Depending on your computer, this could take a few minutes to a couple of hours to complete. You can minimize AVG and continue using your computer, but you may notice a decrease in computer performance while AVG scans.
7. If AVG detects a threat, follow the on-screen instructions to remove it. You may be required to reboot your computer to complete the removal of a threat.
